**Arrow Christian Academy** exists to support homeschooling families in which the parent is the primary educator of their children. Arrow Christian Academy was formed to enrich, encourage and equip homeschooling families through a Christ-centered education. The mission is to allow families to aim together in educating, loving and discipling their children. Arrow is a drop-off academic & enrichment program that supports parents in their role as the primary educators of their children by offering a structured classroom model to complement their studies at home. Classes meet on Fridays and are offered in an 'a la carte' manner to allow parents to choose which classes are best suited for their child.

**Arrow Academics** offers classes for middle and high school students on Wednesdays, with additional electives offered on Fridays. Designed to be a partnership with homeschooling parents, these courses will continue Arrow's commitment to a Christian worldview and will be designed to both strengthen study skills and achieve a high academic standard. Depending on the course, there may be prerequisites to maintain academic standards and classroom success, and both math and modern foreign language will meet two days a week (Wednesday & Friday).

**Discipleship Model:** Arrow seeks to come alongside you as you disciple your children in the ways of character, integrity, respect and faith in Jesus Christ. As a 1-2 day a week educational model, our class community days are highly valuable. In order for our classroom time to be successful & in order to respect teachers and fellow students, Arrow maintains a low tolerance code of conduct. Students should be developmentally ready for a classroom setting and follow the teachers'/staff's directions the first time given, being respectful at all times. We look forward to partnering with our families to sharpen these precious arrows as they aim to launch into the Lord's purposes for their lives. May the Lord richly bless you as you consider what role Arrow has in your academic plans next year!

## **Application and Registration Details 2021-2022**

- **Application & Registration Dates:**

- ❖ Returning family Registration- 9 AM Wednesday, March 31st
- ❖ New family Application- 9 AM Wednesday, \*March 31st

\*If application becomes available earlier, a notification email will be sent to all families who have inquired or signed up for Open House

- **New Family Application/Registration Details:**

- ❖ **New Families must be sponsored by an existing Arrow family. This means that a current Arrow family gives a recommendation & is willing to help mentor/guide the new family as they acclimate to Arrow.**
  - **If a new family does not know an existing Arrow family who can sponsor them, then a 3rd reference will be collected at the time of application for our interview team to contact.**

- ❖ **New family application process begins Wednesday, March 31st. Once the family has applied online and paid the \$25 non-refundable new family application fee, an interview time will be set up within 2-3 weeks. \*\*Please check your email for the interview date/time.**
- ❖ **After the application is finished, reference forms received back and interview is completed, new families will be notified with an invitation to register using a registration code to complete the registration process online.**
- **Arrow Registration Guide:** Please read carefully as each step is crucial to a successful class enrollment.
  - All applications & registrations are online, including your initial payment.
  - Although you will complete one application per family, you will complete one registration per child, which means that when registering, **you will check out one time for each student/child**.
  - **Email Address:** When registering, please use an email that you use often & will check all year for details with class schedules, homework, class supplies & events.
  - Please enter the grade level and birthdate for your first student. (\*remember, you will repeat the registration process/check-out process once for every child you are registering)
  - You can view the class offerings online by grade, period and by subject using the drop down on upper right. In addition you can view by Class Schedule. First listed is the Friday program followed by the upper level Wednesday classes.
  - **Printable Schedule:** It is helpful in planning to print the PDF of the class schedules to use as a reference for planning each child's schedule.
  - **Change Fee:** Consider your class load carefully, reading the descriptions & homework expectations. There is a \$20 drop/change fee per change order drop or change classes once registered. There is a "Change Request" link on the website. Once you have checked out and completed a registration, you will use the **Change Form** for any changes to your registration.
  - **Arrow Academics Classes:** We recommend families who are new to homeschooling take no more than 2 Wednesday Academic classes. Electives with a little/no homework load are great supplements for homework- heavy academic classes.
  - **Pre-Requisites:** Please note the prerequisites for Latin, Math, Science and English classes.
  - **Class Petition:** If you are requesting a Class Petition for your child to be enrolled in a class above/below the grade level of the class, you must complete the petition form online before you register. If you register for a class that does not match your student's grade level, Arrow will move your student to a study hall until the petition has been completed and approved. Arrow does not guarantee that a space will be available in that class if your petition is submitted after enrollment opens.
- **Annual Tuition & Fees:**
  1. Registration fee is \$200 per student until May 1, 2021 and \$250 after May 1, 2021.

2. Class fees are stated with a range. The **monthly pay option** is the cost of each class. The **annual pay option** (paid in full by June 1, 2021) is the discounted cost.  
**\*\*Example:** A class may cost \$350 if you pay monthly, but it is discounted to \$300 if you pay in full by June 1, 2021. On the web site it will be stated \$300-350. Please choose the same payment option for all classes in your student's cart.
  
3. At registration, your check out payment will include the following:
  - a. Registration fee: \$200 (or \$250 after May 1, 2021) per student
  - b. **Science/Little Arrows fees:** Arrow Academics Science labs- \$50 supply fee  
Little Arrows Supply fee- \$50
  - c. **For monthly pay option:** \$50 per class of tuition as a down payment, which is applied to the full cost of the class. You will then pay the balance of your tuition in 9 additional payments. The 2nd payment will be due June 1st, and the remaining 8 monthly payments end on February 1<sup>st</sup>. LATE FEES (\$25) WILL BE APPLIED.
  - d. **For full pay option:** \$50 per class of tuition as a down payment, which is applied to the full cost of the class. You will then receive an invoice to pay the balance of your tuition in full by June 1st. LATE FEES (\$25) WILL BE APPLIED.
  
- **Review your Cart:** Use the cart to once again review your classes and schedule for your student. Confirm that you have done the following before proceeding to checkout:
  - chosen only 1 class per period (not 2 classes in the same period) per day
  - chosen only one type of payment option (annual pay vs. monthly pay) consistently for all selected classes
  - chosen a lunch period if your student will be on campus for lunch
  - chosen classes for the correct grade level of your child
  - verified that all class selections are for one student in your family in your cart
  
- **Checkout:** \*You will checkout separately for each student you register
  1. You will be required to eSign the following documents for each student you register:
    - ◆ Participation Agreement
    - ◆ Medical Release Forms
    - ◆ Financial Agreement: **Agree to pay in full if withdrawal is after July 31, 2021**
    - ◆ Volunteer Form
  2. **Payment:** You will use either ECheck (no fees) or a CC with a \$20 service fee. If all future payments will be made with a CC, a 3% CC fee will be applied to the total charge amount and the initial \$20 fee will be applied.

- **Additional Registration Details:**

1. **\*\*Confirmation Email\*\***: You will receive an email to confirm your child's registration & enrollment with their schedule once all requirements are satisfied. **PLEASE CONFIRM YOUR CHILD'S SCHEDULE WHEN PROMPTED BY EMAIL.**
2. **Invoice**: You will receive one invoice per child via Intuit QB with complete charges based on the payment option you chose. (Discounted payment in full by June 1, 2021 or 9 monthly payments from June 2021 through February 2022) **LATE FEES (\$25) FOR ALL PAYMENTS WILL BE ADDED.**
3. **Welcome Letter**: In July, you will receive a welcome letter directly from each teacher concerning curriculum and necessary supplies for each class.
4. **Workshops & Placement Tests**: You will be notified concerning any parent/student training, placement tests or workshops necessary for enrollment. These apply primarily to writing, lab science, dual credit, and math classes.
